Nominate an Innovator for one of the 2007 IBM System i Innovation Awards

Individuals and organizations that have discovered innovative ways to utilize their System i platform are in luck. Now is the time to nominate someone—perhaps yourself—for one of the IBM System i Innovation Awards. Any System i customer is eligible for nomination, and the submission deadline for the 2007 awards is end-of-day on Wednesday, February 28, 2007. You can fill out a nomination form online at IBM's Web site at www-914.ibm.com/events/systemi/innovationawards07.

IBM has teamed up with COMMON to offer these awards for the third year in a row. "IBM and COMMON wanted to create a program to annually recognize those leaders who are consistently striving to unleash innovation and deliver greater business value and cutting-edge solutions," explains Mark Shearer, IBM System i general manager.

A committee of representatives from both organizations will select the award recipients. Each winner will receive an engraved Tiffany crystal award, a complimentary one-year membership to COMMON, and five complimentary registrations to COMMON's 2008 Annual Conference. Each of the award finalists will receive two complimentary one-day passes for the 2007 Annual Conference and will be honored at a special dinner at the conference in Anaheim, California. European finalists will have their own in London in May. Winners will be announced during the dinners.

And the Categories Are...

The IBM System i Innovation Awards will recognize award winners in the following six categories:

Solutions Innovation: Nominees in this category should demonstrate innovative implementations of industry, business applications or other solutions, including RPG, COBOL, and Java running on the System i platform. Submitted solutions might include applications such as IP Telephony, Web transaction applications, as well as creative implementations for more traditional business solutions such as CRM and ERP.

Business Resiliency: Nominations for this award should illustrate solutions that are focused on business continuity and resiliency. These solutions should demonstrate the best practices of high availability, security and compliance, and business protection using System i.

Infrastructure Simplification: This award demonstrates the versatility of the System i platform. Nominees need to demonstrate cost-effective server management, application integration, capacity on demand or other overall IT simplification solutions deployed on System i. This would include, but is not limited to, the integration of IBM BladeCenter and System x servers or the use of the Linux and AIX 5L on the System i platform.

i5/OS Focus: Nominees know that the magic of System i technology is captured in the innovation of i5/OS solutions. This award is for the best example of using i5/OS as *the* strategic and primary operating environment for running your entire business.

Education Excellence: Nominees for this award will have demonstrated an on-going commitment to providing quality education for the IBM System i platform. The client, college, or university can provide education support in a variety of forms, including, but not limited to, curriculum, sponsorship, and support for students and instructors.

Community Support: This award is designed to recognize outstanding contributions to the System i community. Nominees for this award will be those individuals or groups who have demonstrated passion for the IBM System i platform, including community volunteers, IBM partners, and other organizations such as user groups.
