# "What's New with CL These Days ... and Anything Else You Want to Know"

Unless you've been living in a cave for the last five years, you've heard that IBM has been shaking up the Control Language which is a cornerstone of the IBM i operating system. Guy will cover the improvements made to CL starting in V5R3 all the way up to the most recent improvements shipped in release 7.1 of IBM i. Guy will also explain some of the rationale for why these particular changes were made and what the potential benefits are for programs written partially or completely in CL. Time will also be available to ask Guy questions about CL or anything else concerning IBM i development.

Guy Vig is a senior software engineer with IBM Systems and Technology Group and has worked in Rochester, Minnesota and Toronto, Ontario on various parts of the operating system and compiler products for System/38, AS/400, iSeries, System i5, and IBM i since joining IBM in 1978.
